New boss for constituency kitty hits out at governors

The Council of Governors has been warned against meddling in the affairs of the newly re-branded National Government Constituency Development Fund (NG-CDF). The fund chairman Elias Mbau said his board would help bridge the development gap left out by devolved units.
